In the morning

- History and culture of Toro
Towards the 15th century Toro played an important role in the kingdom of the "Catholic kings". It was Royal Court. The famous 83 laws of Toro, 1505, laid the basis for the construction of Spain, the "oldest" country in Europe. year 1505. Famous historic personalities like Christopher Columbus or Amerigo Vespucci stayed in Toro.
- Visit to the Colegiata. Explaining the "Portico de la Gloria" a work of art, declared as world cultural heritage.
